

Fair & Ethical Trading Policy

By using Fair Trade products and suppliers (for example Fair Trade Coffee) wherever possible, we can help send powerful signals to other businesses and clients about their concerns for justice and ethics in trade. This will encourage other Suppliers to develop Fair Trade ranges & encourage governments in the commercial potential.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the commitment from our suppliers and products to:

- Ethically trade and adopt a code of labour practice that they expect to work towards, such as addressing issues like wages, hours of work, health and safety and the right to join free trade unions
- To focus on trading with poor and marginalised producer groups, helping them develop skills and sustainable livelihoods through the trading relationship
- Pay fair prices that cover the full cost of production and enable a living wage and other fair rewards to be earned by producers
- Provide credit when needed to allow orders to be fulfilled
- Encourage the fair treatment of all workers, ensuring good conditions in the workplace and throughout the supply chain, and aims to build up long-term relationships, rather than looking for short-term commercial advantage
- This policy represents a commitment from Churchill Catering Ltd to introduce Fair Trade products wherever commercially possible and where the supplier can demonstrate transparency and traceability with open audit availability
